

# Key Messages South Regional Advisory Forum – June 2025

## NHS Supply Chain Updates and Regional Focus

- £95 million in total savings reported regionally; £21.6 million from the South.
- Performance improvements attributed to direct trust engagement.
- Inflationary pressures remain a concern for sustaining savings.
- There is a need for clarity and consistency in savings data reporting.
- · Local activities offer potential to offset cost pressures but require coordination.

## Simplify to Strengthen

- Restructure announced:
  - Removal of regional lead roles.
  - New Customer Engagement Director appointed.
  - Formation of Strategic Engagement and Service Support Teams.
  - o Integration of Communications, Marketing, and Customer Voice.
- Aimed at improving customer relationships and strategic alignment.

## **Clinical and Quality of Care Strategy**

- Strategy focuses on:
  - 1. Promoting quality of care.
  - Strengthening NHS partnerships.
    Supporting population health.
- Includes essential patient safety training for all NHS Supply Chain staff.
- Development of a Clinical Education Academy.
- Three new corporate KPIs will drive accountability and alignment with patient-centric goals.

## **Data Visualisation Tool**

- New dashboard tool allows trusts to visualise spend and identify opportunities.
- Future roadmap includes:
  - Handling multi-DoH codes.
  - Automated reporting of rejected opportunities.
- Potential for wider spend integration beyond NHS Supply Chain.
- Tool under development in collaboration with NHSE to avoid duplication.

## **ICS and Collaborative Working**

- Clinical Engagement and Capacity are a common challenge across the region.
- Data Quality and Resource Gaps highlighted
- Shift required from strategic conversation to delivery.
