Subject: Temporary BodyComm™ 3.3 Unavailability – Pump Safety and Servicing Options

Dear Valued Customer,

Thank you for reaching out and sharing your concerns regarding the potential upcoming temporary unavailability of BodyComm™ 3.3.

We want to reassure you that **the pumps remain fully safe to use**. BodyComm<sup>™</sup> 3.3 is an **optional utility tool** designed to support servicing workflows—it is not required for the safe operation of the pumps.

Starting **15 October**, BodyComm<sup>™</sup> 3.3 may be temporarily unavailable due to the **end of support for Windows 10** and the transition to **Windows 11**. To ensure continued compatibility, we are preparing to release a **new cable** that will enable BodyComm<sup>™</sup> 3.3 to communicate seamlessly with Windows **11**. This cable is expected to be available by the **end of October**, and no later than **end of November**.

In the meantime, you have the following options for servicing:

- If you wish to use BodyComm, we recommend servicing pumps that are approaching their service due date before 15 October.
- Manual servicing remains available, although it may be more time-consuming.
- You may also choose to wait for the new cable release, as it is only a matter of weeks away.
