## Patient Temperature Management Blanket Warming Cabinets Support Document

## Introduction

Information for Clinical Choice (ICC) has been developed to assist Clinicians in the decision-making process when assessing the suitability of a product by providing a clear illustration and description of the features of a range of similar products supplied through NHS Supply Chain.

Blanket warming cabinets are used across hospitals including critical care areas, A&E resus rooms and theatre recovery, for warming blankets and any textiles for the maintenance of normothermia and the comfort of the patient.

The criteria provided, in the form of a Product Matrix and Support Document, is the result of a product review conducted by the clinical team in the Category Management Service Provider with support from clinical stakeholders from across the NHS as part of our assurance process.

The aim, alongside delivering savings back into NHS frontline services, is to ensure that clinical choice remains at the forefront of any product switching decision.
