

Nationally Contracted Products (NCP) procurement notification:

NCP General Wound Care Dressings Procurement activity achieves 13.26% (£1.4 million)* national savings opportunitys



Summary

Four of these NCP's are renewal's and two are brand new areas. The aim of the four NCP renewals was to aggregate national demand to provide a sustainable competitive price for the NHS. The two new NCP areas were chosen due to the savings potential and the ability to ensure resilience and continuity of supply. Supply chain resilience is essential and so all participating suppliers are required to provide assurance of their capability to fulfil volume requirements.
