- 1. Product Framework Clinical Quality Assurance Vision a new clinical quality assessment and assurance framework with 10 standards will be used for all new health care products frameworks from January 2025. - 2. Greener NHS Plan and Sustainability initiatives were discussed with more focus on reduce use across the NHS and on circular economy with reusable health care products and medical devices. - 3. Future agenda items include a focus on opportunities in relation to improving value of health care products and medical devices through a programme led by NHS England on new clinically evaluated core product list.
