# What's New?

In response to customer feedback, we regularly work on various bug fixes and performance improvements for our eDC android devices. Below are the latest updates being released.

## General

- The error message of "Not eDC Gold User" should no longer appear when experiencing network issues

## Communications

- Improved performance to loading the stock catalogue
- Improved performance to load store
- Improved performance when loading all stores
- Removed obsolete data from the load store process
- Loading stores where multiple users have logged into the software issues have been resolved
- Loading stores now warns and allow users to cancel the load store if there are pending transactions to be sent

## eDC

- The requisition data list will no longer be stuck at the bottom of the page when returning from the amend screen
- When Returning from "full screen mode" the viewable data will no longer be cut-off
- Additional safeguards now in place to prevent duplicate data lines, preventing data from being uploaded
- The quantity fields will now display an error if text is entered and also prevents NPC barcodes being scanned

## eDC Gold

- The incorrect error message no longer appears when assigning a barcode to a product, where the barcode is assigned to an undefined product in the selected store
- When assigning a barcode to a product where the barcode exists as a GTIN in the local catalogue now displays the correct message
- Within write-back users can now remove the default "1" quantity and input more than 2 digits into the quantity field
- The batch selection screen will now find the batch number whether manually inputting and/or scanning the batch number
- Manually associated barcodes will now be prioritized over barcodes in the local catalogue
