

eDC Android Release Notes

What's New?

In response to customer feedback, we regularly work on various bug fixes and performance improvements for our eDC android devices. Below are the latest updates being released.

General

- The error message of 'Not an eDC Gold User' no longer appears when there may have been a network connectivity issue (EDC-760)
- The 'No stores' message within the comms log when loading MMDs will no longer be displayed (EDC-761)

Catalogue

- Browsing the Local Catalogue for NPC, Supplier Reference, and Supplier Name filters are now displaying correctly (EDC-778)
- MPC filter within Browse Local Catalogue always showing only one product now shows the product selected (EDC-779)
- You can now select products within any of the Browse Trees, except for MPCs (EDC-780)
- We have corrected various spelling errors within the Browse Local Catalogue function (EDC-802)

eDC

- Within Requirement View when Auto Advance is enabled with a Manual Requirement, the correct field now remains when moving to the next product (EDC-64)
- When changing the sort order in the Req Data screen (View Data mode) the wrong product will no longer be selected to amend (EDC-773)











eDC Gold

- Receipting now allows for serial numbers that have previously been in stock to be receipted again this will display a warning message asking the user to confirm this receipt (EDC-637)
- There will no longer be a Shelf-Life alert if receipting a product defined using the Store's default Short Shelf Life days, with the product having an expiry date of more than 30 days life (EDC823/INC24899861)
- Within Return to Stock the Client now shows the Client Name rather than the Client Full name (EDC-657)
- Within Stock Check when deleting a quantity that has been added via the Add New Item function will no longer display a ghost value against the product (EDC-76)
- When selecting Put Away All option on all and individual products now refreshes the screen correctly (EDC-765/767)
- When selecting Complete All within Stock Check now refreshes the screen correctly (EDC-717)
- The Busy Spinner will now display when doing Put Away All on all and individual products (EDC-766/768)
- When Put Away All is used, there is no longer an issue for multipack products where Receipt UOM = Issue UOM (EDC-789/790)
