What's New?

In response to customer feedback, we regularly work on various bug fixes and performance improvements for our eDC web application. Below are the latest updates being released.

eDC

- New Feature: To support off site stores, you can now automatically send a demand Picking List email to Suppliers of Internal Requirements after processing Internal Demand (EDC-798)
- When saving new MMDs where there is no current active MMD no longer displays a server error (EDC-702)
- New requisition points can now be saved when all required options are prepopulated (EDC-450)


eDC Gold

- When using the Add Suggested Demand function, there are no longer calculation errors (EDC-770)
- Within the Stock View screen, we have fixed the RAG status icon where it was not showing the correct colour for multipacks for products On Order (EDC-771)
- Lapsed planned orders will now properly clear from Planned Receipting. This was caused when an order line that had been partially receipted. These will now also be cleared. (EDC-824/INC24913153)

New Feature: Internal Pick Demand Email

In our previous release of eDC Web, we introduced a new Internal Pick Location field in the Local Catalogue. We have now made further improvements to this to enable a Demand Picking List to be emailed to recipients. This capability supports managing off site central stores. The process is as follows:

In the New/Edit Supplier pop-out box of Internal Suppliers (which shows only when the Internal Checkbox is ticked on Local Catalogue product) there is now an option to enable the sending of an email (or emails) to individual Internal Suppliers. By default, this option is not enabled and requires a valid email address. (Note: this option will not show on the catalogue's new/edit supplier page)













- When Processing Internal Demand, a list will display showing the suppliers' email addresses which have been sent Internal Demand Picking Lists.
- Each individual Internal Supplier which has the email option enabled will receive an email per supplier (even if the same email address is used across different suppliers). This will contain all the products within the Demand for that supplier, including the Description, Internal Pick Location and Quantity (in Internal Pick Location sort order).
