

# eDC Web Application Release Notes

1 September 2022 eDC Web Application Version 1.2.0













## What's New?

In response to customer feedback, we regularly work on various bug fixes and performance improvements for our eDC web application. Below are the latest updates being released.

#### eDC

- Within MMD Config, saving a Requisition Point without an External Location selected will no longer cause a Server Error (EDC-413)
- Fixed adding a New MMD when no Warehouse/MMD is selected causing a Server Error (EDC-719)
- Fixed the behaviour of the Create/Edit Req point screen when an invalid Price Break Percentage is entered (EDC-438)
- Fixed an incorrect 404 error when selecting Import Requirements when no other Req Points exist within the MMD (EDC-416)
- Within External Locations the date picker will now correctly validate dates on Chromium-based web browsers (Chrome and Edge) (EDC-599)
- The Transmission time will no longer show within External Location Amend when batch transmission isn't enabled (EDC-764)
- Changed the 'none' feed type to 'Select feed type' in the feed type field. The external location can't be saved when this is selected. (EDC-424)
- Clarified the error message when an invalid IP is entered within External Location (EDC-386)
- Fixed the wrapping of the Location Name field which was obscuring the FTP protocol entry field (EDC-417)
- The new Internal Pick Location column (released in the previous version) will no longer show for Stock and External Demand detail reports (EDC-667)
- Stock and External Demand detail reports have their sort order reverted to Scanned Order (as scanned from the Hand-Held device). Internal Demand detail report remains sorted by Internal Pick Location. (EDC-759)
- Corrected the Total Quantity value to zero decimal places in the Demand detail report (EDC-695)
- Within the Catalogue screen, fixed long supplier names causing formatting issues with the search entry fields (EDC-714)
- Fixed the inability to Search for Stock type products in the Catalogue screen (EDC-756)
- If leaving the Demand Management Screen with unsaved changes a warning will now show (EDC-769)









#### eDC Gold

- Within Manage Hierarchy it's no longer possible to make Stores active or add new Stores within Inactive Sites (EDC-708/390)
- Increased the upper limit to the Store's Receipt Lead-time field to 100 days (from 20 days) (EDC-716)
- Removed the Description column being used for filtering when filtering by NPC/GTIN within the Transaction Log (EDC-720)

### **Reports**

- Requisition Reports The Demand Created from and to fields are now labelled Red to indicate they are mandatory. (EDC-678)
- Order Status Report (Gold only) Second attempt (from the Previous release) to remove the non-receipted zero outstanding order lines from the report (cross-docked orders) (EDC-754)
- Order Status Report (Gold only) Excel Export The Expected Delivery date column is now set to the proper Date format (EDC-692)
- Order Status Report (Gold only) In Firefox browsers, restricted the date to 365 days previous, which is already restricted in other browser types (EDC-694)
- Order Status Report (Gold only) The data returned in the report is now Inclusive of the date entered in the Date From field (EDC-713)
- Authorisation Report Excel Export Corrected the formatting of the Price and Max value columns (EDC-700)
- Stock Status Report (Gold only) PDF version Incorrect stock values now fixed (EDC-705)
