What's New?

In response to customer feedback, we regularly work on various bug fixes and performance improvements for our eDC web application. Below are the latest updates being released.

General

- Removed FPTs as an FTP server Protocol option in External Locations (EDC-1223).

eDC Reports

- Requirement Report - removed lines with 0 value from the report (EDC-412).
- Requirement Report (PDF and Excel) - added the Product Lead Time and Requisition Point delivery days to the report (EDC-511).
- Inventory Status Report (PDF version) - Req Point Total heading now shows under each requisition point grouping (EDC-445).
- Local Catalogue Report (PDF version) - Expense codes now show all characters (EDC-550).
- Local Catalogue Report (Excel version) - Expense codes now in Text format (rather than Number format) (EDC-552).
- Unit cost and value figures are now displayed to two decimal points and changed to Number format in the following Excel reports: Authorisation Summary, (Gold): Short Shelf Life, Stock Consignment Holding and Issue, and Transaction Report (EDC-553, 554, 555, 557, 559).

eDC Gold

- Within Manage Hierarchy - New Store, the Requisition Point now shows as mandatory (Red) (EDC-422).
- Replanned Receipt - searching with GTIN now brings up products if the order has been cross-docked (C order number) (EDC-1109).
- Receipting - stopped copy function being able to copy serial tracked items (EDC-1169).
- Transfer - now allows transfer between Stores on different Sites if the sending Store is the only Store on its Site (EDC-807).

eDC Gold Reports

- Transaction Report and Order Status Report (initial screens) - mandatory fields are now red (EDC-523, 808).
- Stock Status Report (PDF version) - now shows products with nil stock. (EDC-706).
- Transfer - now allows transfer between Stores on different Sites if the sending Store is the only Store on its Site (EDC-807).
